The Journal of Electrology: The Journal, published twice yearly by the AEA, contains educational articles specifically written for the electrologist. A home study test is included at the end of each publication which may be completed and returned to the CERC for scoring. A processing fee of \$20 (\$35 for non-AEA members) is required for grading and entry into the computer database. AEA members receive the journal free of charge.
