

EXPLANATION OF THE AEA ORGANIZATIONAL CHART

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The AEA Board of Directors (BOD) is the governing body.

The Board consists of the Officers,
Immediate Past President,
Delegates representing Affiliate States,
two Delegates-At-Large representing unaffiliated members.

The non-voting members of the Board are:

Executive Director
Director, Office of Continuing Education (OCE)
Director, International Board of Electrologist Certification (IBEC)
Director, Council On Accreditation (COA), and
Committee Chairmen

DUTIES AND POWERS

The duties and powers of the Board shall be to manage the affairs, funds and property of the Association. The Board shall establish programs and committees to further the objectives of the Association and prescribe rules and procedures for such programs and committees,

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive Committee consists of
the President, three Vice-Presidents, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and
the Immediate Past President.

The non-voting members of the Executive Committee are
the Executive Director and the Directors of OCE, IBEC and COA.

DUTIES AND POWERS

The Executive Committee shall manage the affairs, funds and property of the Association, and other duties as may be assigned by the Board, between meetings of the Board of Directors. The Committee may recommend policies, procedures, and resolutions for Association programs and committees.

PRESIDENT

The President presides at all meetings of the Association, appoints committee chairmen and fills vacancies occurring in the Executive Committee, with Board approval. The President is an ex-officio member of all programs and committees with the exception of the Nominating Committee.
